



## Portuguese for Foreigners – Level A1

### Aims of the course

This course will allow each participant to:

- ▶ Acquire general notions about the Portuguese language;
- ▶ Create the grammatical and vocabulary bases for a in-depth language learning;
- ▶ Formulate and write simple sentences;
- ▶ Write simple texts;
- ▶ Understand simple dialogues in Portuguese.

### Who this course is for

- ▶ Anyone wishing to have basic knowledge of Portuguese.

### Teaching methods

This course comprises:

- ▶ Presentations and methodological syntheses;
- ▶ Use of teaching materials such as:
  - o Worksheets;
  - o Articles;
  - o Videos and films;
- ▶ Dialogues related to the participants' reality;
- ▶ Practice speaking and listening;
- ▶ Phonetics and writing exercises;
- ▶ Recognition, understanding and use of structure of speech;
- ▶ Role-play and simulations of conversation situations;
- ▶ Motivational and educational games.

### Assessment

Continuous assessment of participation in class in addition to 2 intermediate written tests and 1 final test (oral and written).

Successful completion requires a result positive in the evaluation and a minimum attendance of 70% of the total course duration.
